Commitment to Canadian Certification

Transport Canada adopted technical standards that Electronic Logging Devices (ELDs) must meet for use within Canadian borders after June 12, 2021. Several of these technical standards include deviations and additions from the U.S. ELD framework and all ELD providers are required to address these differences in order to be certified in Canada.

KeepTruckin has submitted our ELD for certification on both the Android and iOS platforms and is undergoing testing with all accredited certification bodies for ELDs in Canada. We will continue to take the necessary steps to ensure that our ELD is certified in Canada at the earliest possible date.

While enforcement policies across Canada's 14 different provincial enforcement authorities will vary, each has agreed to delay full enforcement of the ELD Mandate until June 12, 2022. Until then, enforcement will focus on education and awareness. Canadian ELD customers can get early access to KeepTruckin's new Canadian ELD product experience to familiarize themselves with the technology and get ahead of the adoption curve.
